The Evangelical Lutheran Church in Denmark (Folkekirken) is present throughout the Copenhagen area and offers worship, community life, and social engagement for people from many countries and backgrounds. Parish churches are local community institutions. They are places where people meet, share activities, and participate in social, cultural, and spiritual life.
